Endeavour is the working title for Paws for Kids, a unique and diverse support service, making a real difference to all those affected by domestic abuse


The perfect start to our 25th Anniversary...

Annual Review 2021

On Friday 26th November 2021 Endeavour hosted our annual event at the Holiday Inn Bolton. Professionals from across Bolton joined us to hear about or services and how they had been impacted during the Covid crisis.

Jill, our CEO gave an impassioned overview of how the pandemic had given rise to a 72% increase in referrals. She focused on the impact on services and the first year of our Evergreen project which meets the needs of older people. Evergreen has supported service users aged from 55 - 92, including couples. Many are victims of abuse from long term partners, sons and grandsons and had a variety of support needs and outcomes.

Michelle Livesey Feingold our Patron and Clare's Law founder gave an update on how many people have benefitted by requesting Clare's Law and her presentation; her first since the death of Michael Brown, was incredibly emotional as Michael's voice was played to the room with his passion resonating.

Luke Hart was our keynote speaker and spoke about his family and the murder of his mother and sister at the hands of his father. Growing up, the family had not recognised themselves as victims of abuse and it was only following the tragic deaths that Luke and his brother Ryan learned of coercive control from a poster at a police station.

Media reporting of the family heavily focused on their father and so Luke and Ryan set up Coco Awareness to share their story and campaign to have the voice of the victims recognised.

Luke and Ryan are both domestic abuse advocates, active campaigners and authors.

The day ended on a lighter note when Nick Smeeton, our longest serving foster carer, gave a hilarious insight into the antics of some of the 33 cats that he, his wife Karen and daughter Hannah have fostered for us.

It was a day full of happiness, sharing and celebration and we would like to thank all those involved.












Landmark Moment
